Wipe or Air Dry: Use a clean, dry cloth to wipe off any remaining water, or let the panels air dry. This helps prevent water spots and ensures a clear, streak-free finish.

Generally, though, solar panels can be treated similarly to windows or other glass surfaces: Combine water with a mild soap to create a homemade solar panel cleaner.
