A standalone external power supply supplies power outside the main enclosure of an electronic device. It converts AC power from a wall outlet into the DC voltage that the electronic ...

The external power supply provides the isolation, and as long as voltages in your unit are 48V or less and limited to a particular current (I forget the limit), you're basically fine.

Myth: "HDMI/DP can power my monitor." Reality: The tiny auxiliary voltages on HDMI/DP are not designed to power the panel (they just wake up/identify electronics).
